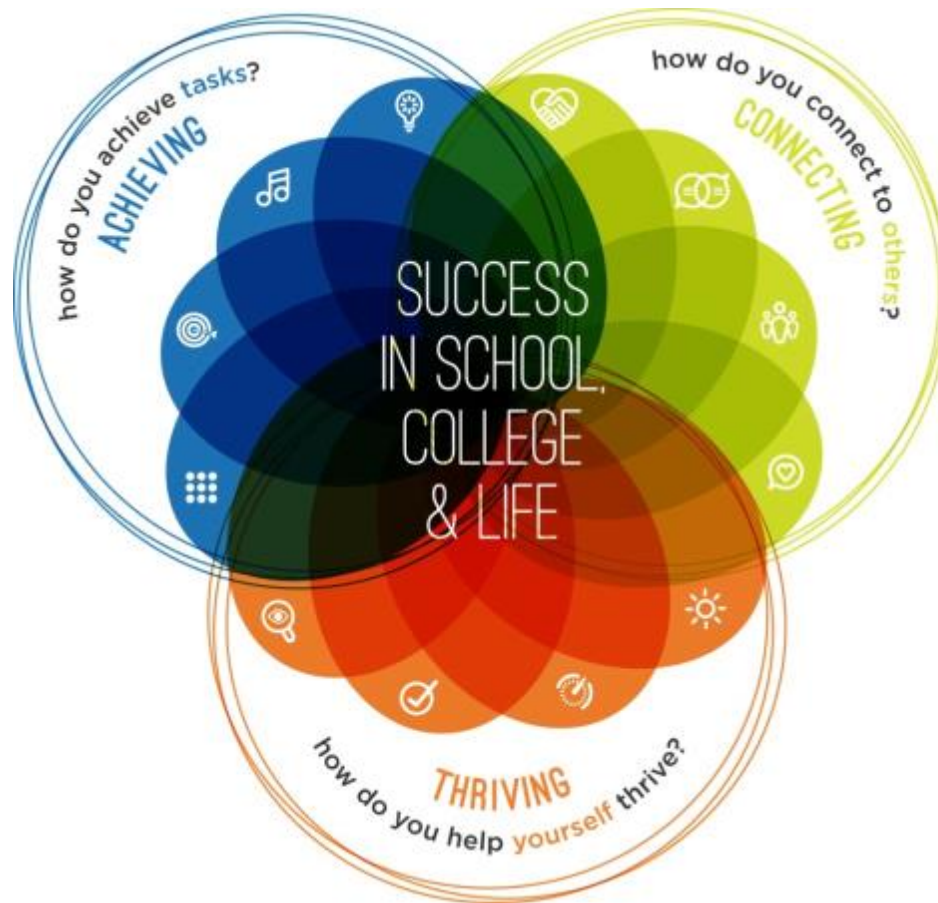

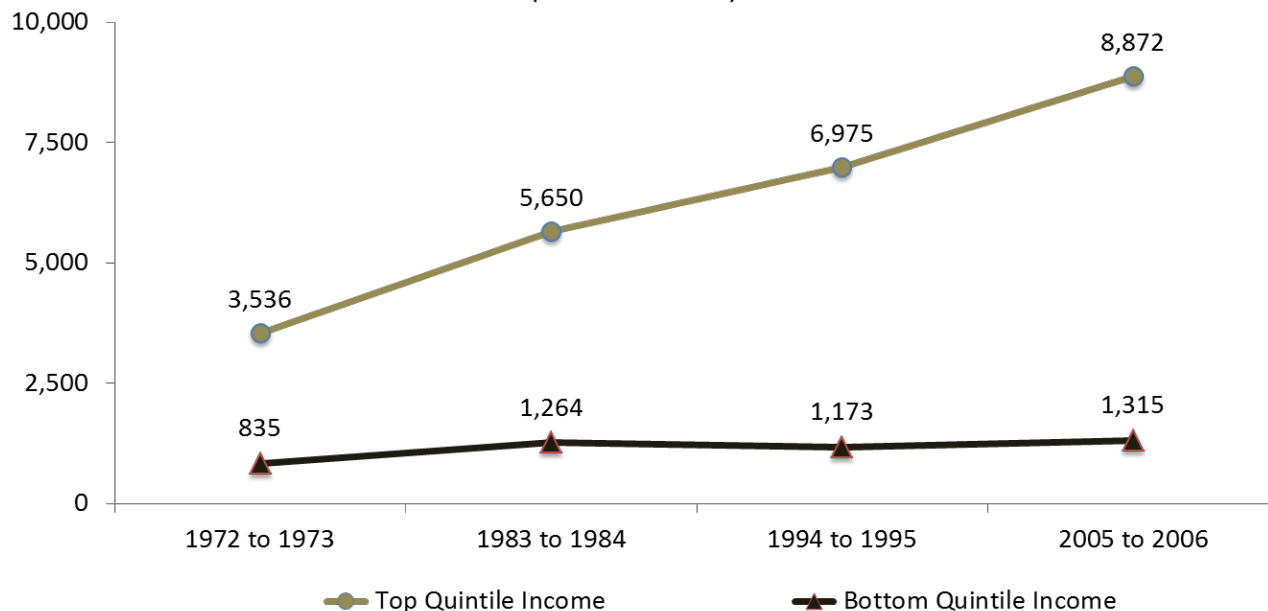

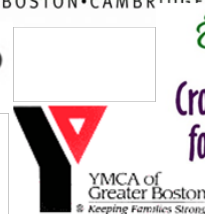

## Spending on enrichment 1972-2008 (in 2008 dollars)



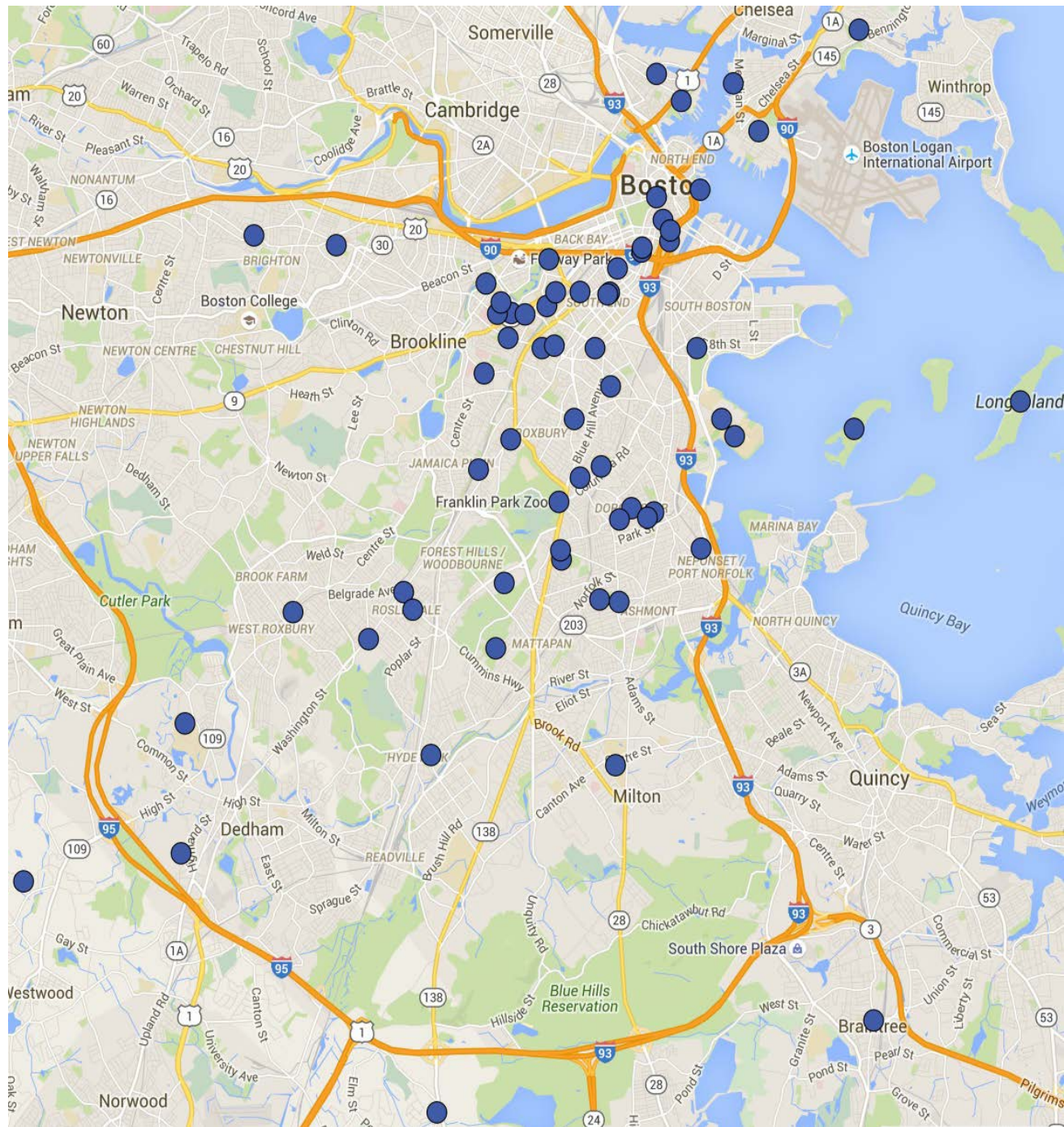

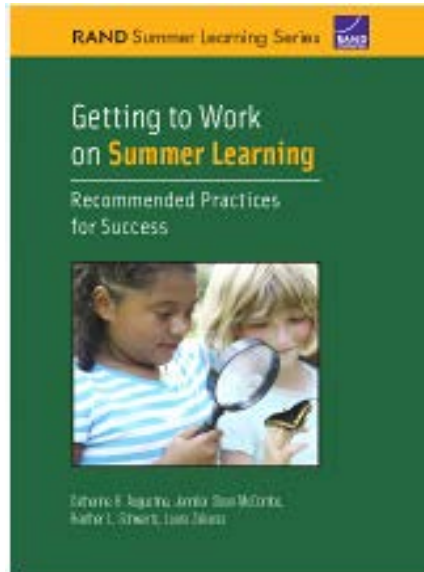

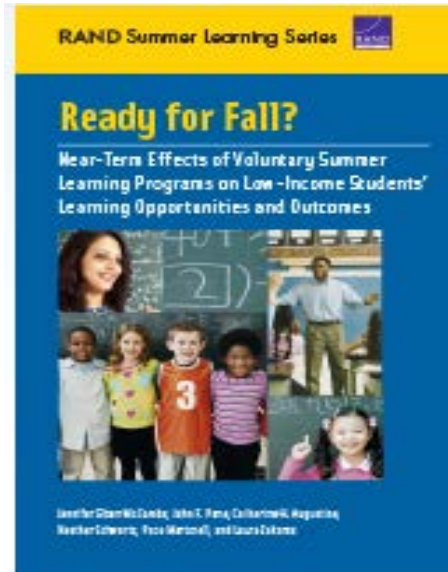
