

### Dramatic growth in size of supervised population



- Why?
  - Not crime
  - Increased probability of conviction
    - Plea rates increased from 80% to 95%
- Does certainty increase when on probation?
  - If supervision decreases crime 10%, how much does this decline?


- Is it net widening?
  - Recidivism rates are constant
  - Demographics such as dropout rate constant


- Not
