By October 1:

Action 1: Suggest revisions to the prospectus for the planned BRDI Competition and Lee Dirks Prize.

Action 2: Respond to Cheryl Levey on candidate dates for the winter 2013 BRDI meeting.

Action 3: Hold telcon with US CODATA Exec Committee on hosting the 2014 or 2016 CODATA Conference and General Assembly.

Action 4: Provide suggestions for dissemination of the following BRDI reports:

- *The Case for International Sharing of Scientific Data—A Focus on Developing Countries*
- *For Attribution: Developing Scientific Data Attribution and Citation Practices and Standards*
- *The Future of Knowledge Discovery in Open Networked Environments*

By October 19:

Action 5: Develop next round of prospectuses for 3 new projects and hold small group telcons on their scope and focus (Cheryl will schedule these):

Action 6: Continue discussions with potential sponsors on: the *Legal Interoperability of Data* workshop; the *Database Sustainability Strategies* study; the *U.S.-China Study on Data Sharing Issues in Earth Observations*; and *USAID RFA on Open Source Development Projects*.

Action 7: Finalize preparations for China-U.S. CODATA Workshop on Data Intensive Science in Shanghai, and for U.S. involvement in CODATA Conference and General Assembly in Taipei.

By November 30:
