# NRC, BPA Activities

- NRC report on women in academia, *Beyond Bias and Barriers*
- BCST report on advanced chemical imaging, *Visualizing Chemistry*
- Triennial Review of NNI, *A Matter of Size*
- Rare Isotope Science Assessment Committee
  - “RIA” is no longer tenable, White House/Congress squabbles (on this issue) on temporary hold
  - Committee hurrying to release a final report before FY2008 budget process too far along
- Survey of Scientific Uses of the Radio (E-M) Spectrum
  - Sponsors satisfied with charge; will move ahead in Jan 2007

# Astronomy


- **NASA Astronomy Performance Assessment**
  - Congressionally requested assessment of NASA Astrophysics Program performance since 2001 with the last decadal survey as a scorecard
  - Chaired by Ken Keller, a biomedical engineer and public-policy expert
- **Astronomy & astrophysics community thinking hard about their next decadal survey**
  - Watching Physics 2010 with interest (recent articles in Nature)
- **Old fire drill: NRC analysis of FY2007 budget request**
  - NASA has too many tasks/responsibilities, not enough resources
- **New fire drill: what about Beyond Einstein?**
  - Series of 5 missions that address phys/astro interface have been delayed and delayed
  - Committee being formed to choose which to go first...

- Report released in July 2006
