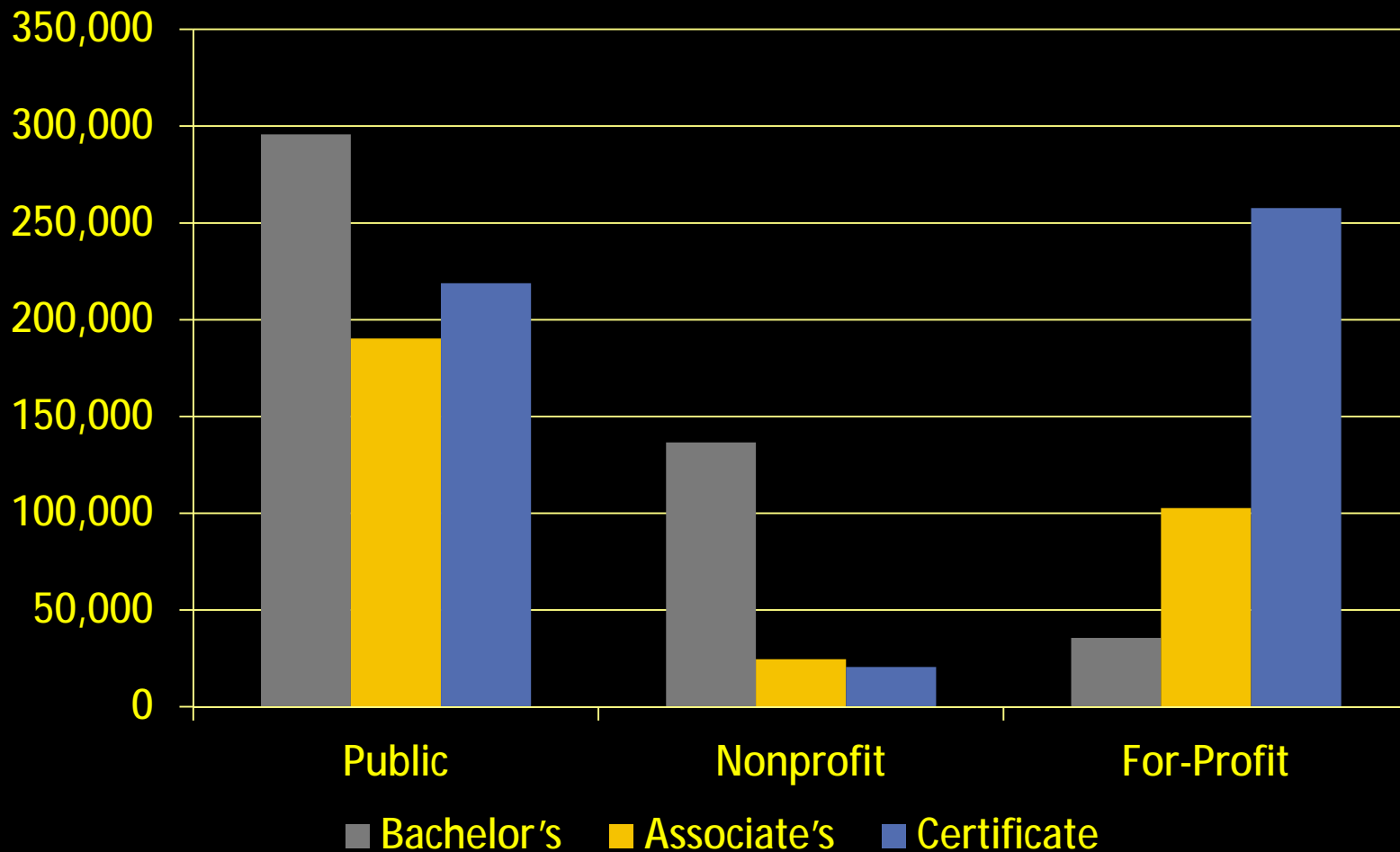

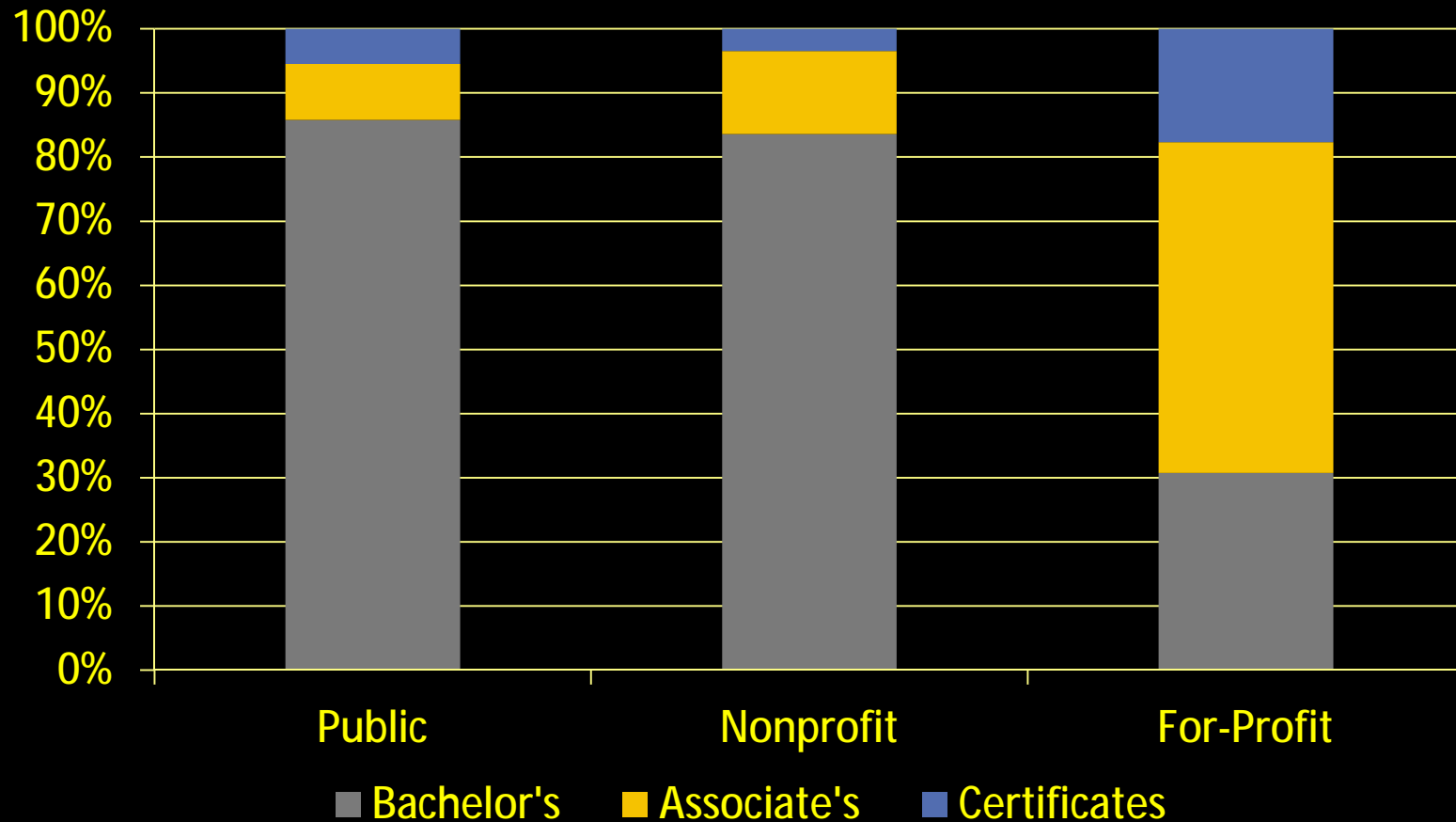

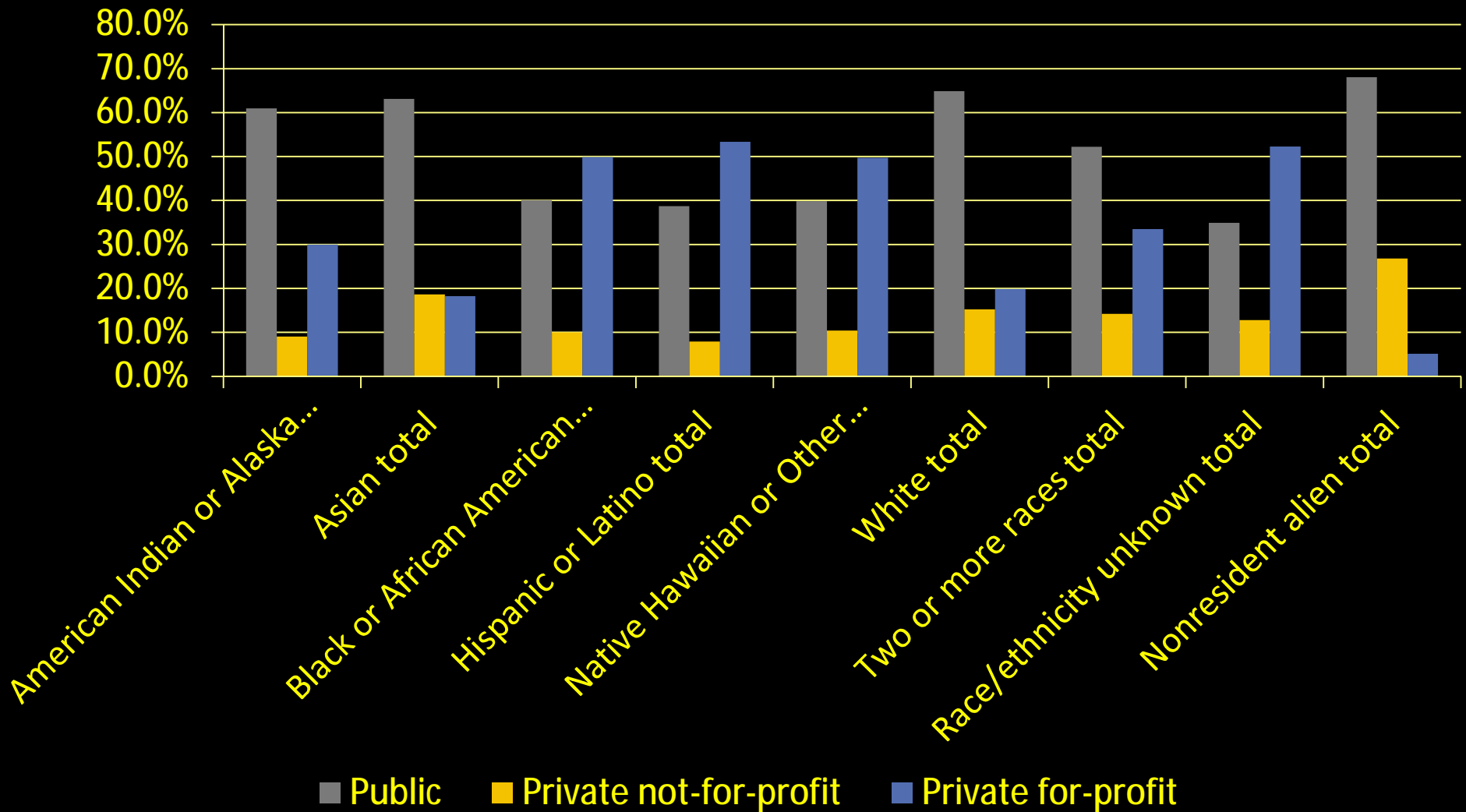
Level of Award in STEM Fields



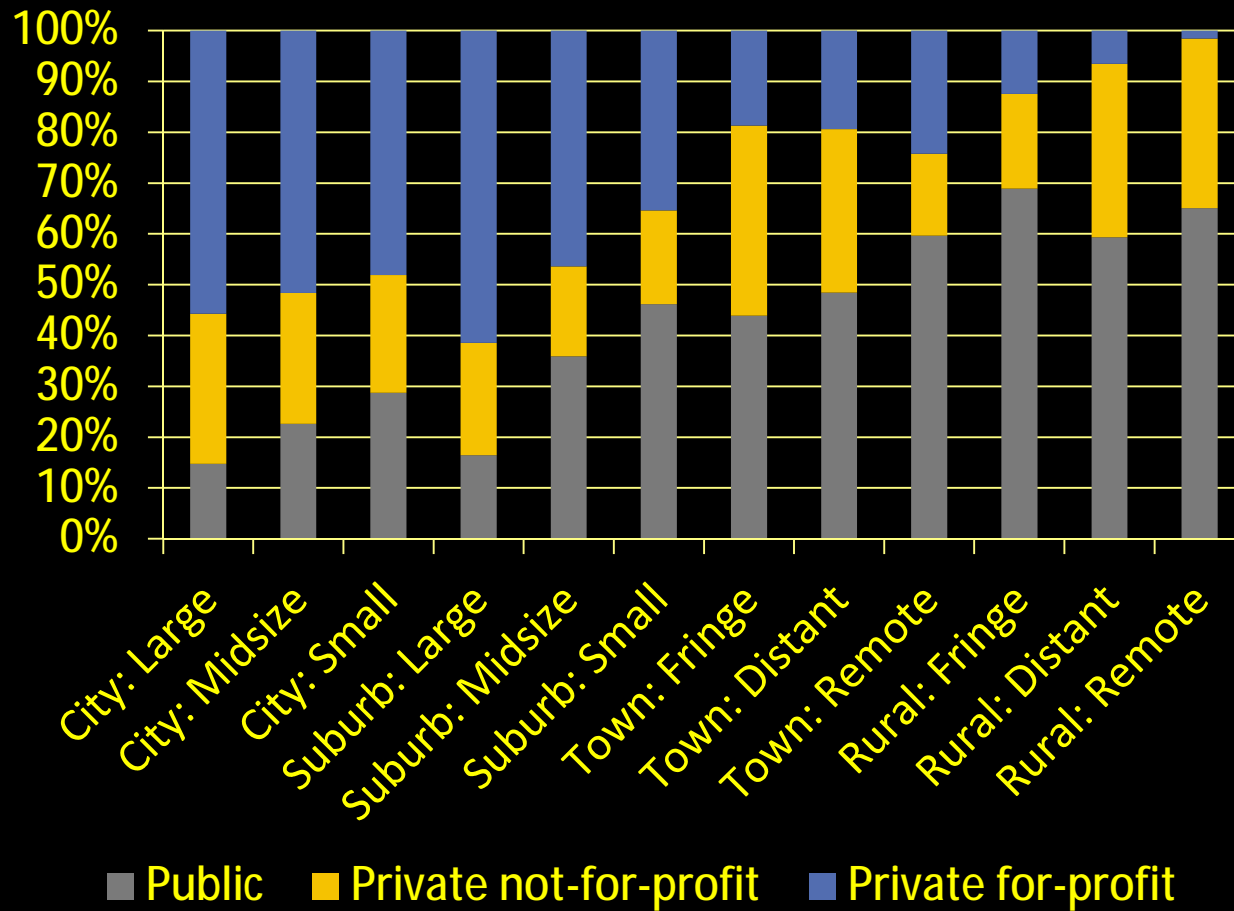
STEM Awards in 4-Year Institutions

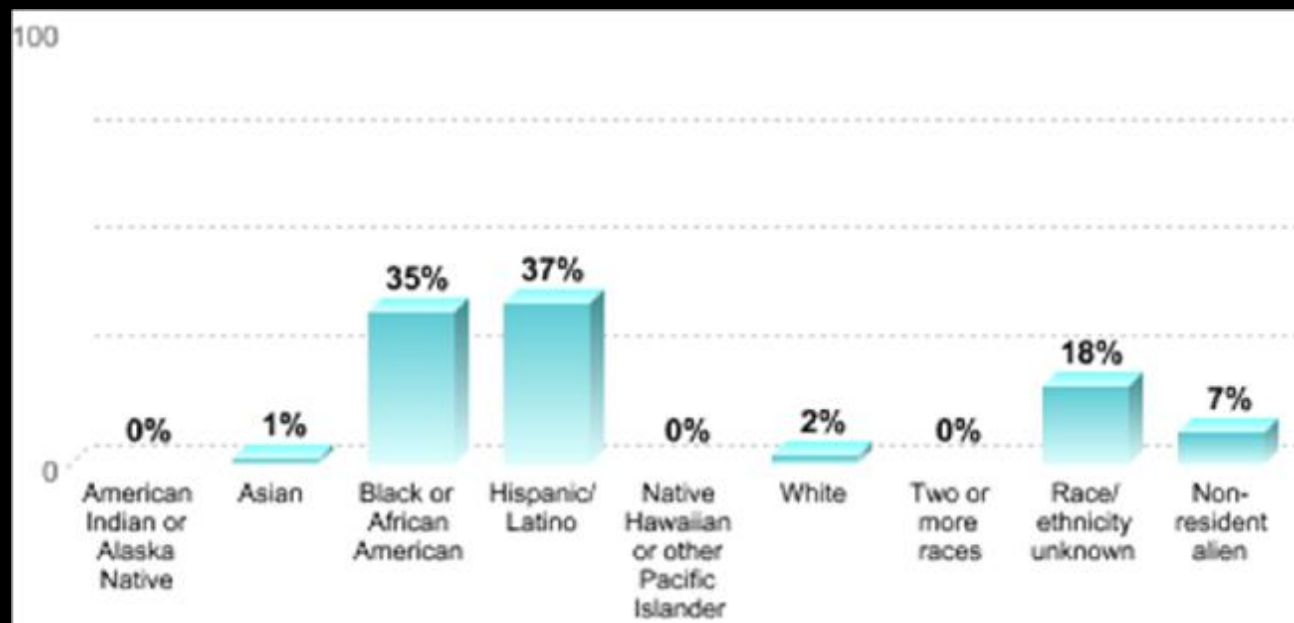
