Results to Date

- Over 40 Faith Leaders committed to training
- Engaged NATAL – Israeli Based Model for Trauma Counseling
 - Completed study of Chicago to determine NATAL Strategy (Phase I)
 - NATAL is here this week for Phase II of program implementation!
- Engaged CTC (Communities that Care)
 - Framework developed from measured Risk and Protective factors in the community
 - Successfully administered CTC Survey to CPS Network 9 (IRB/RRB approved)
72% response rate across 19 Bronzeville schools
- Multiple workgroups underway to address training, care coordination, and network development
- Awarded CDC National Academic Center of Excellence in Youth Violence Prevention
 - \$6,000,000 over 5 years for implementation and evaluation
