

Instructions for Completing the Application Form for Participation in Phase IV of the Federal Demonstration Partnership

Emerging Research Institution Edition – May 2003

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. To complete this application electronically you will need either Acrobat Reader 4 or higher or the full version of Acrobat 4 or higher. The page limit for the application is 5 pages excluding the letter of endorsement. See Item 5 if you are unable to create a pdf file.
2. Complete all of the fields on the cover page. The first field (Institution) can be accessed by left clicking on the field with your mouse. Subsequent fields can be accessed either with the mouse or 'tab' key.
3. Three blank pages follow the cover page. Each of these has a separate heading for the three remaining required sections. You may simply copy each narrative section from a word processing document and paste it into the text field provided.
4. There is a blank page for adding the letter of endorsement. You can also email this signed document as part of your pdf file. If not submitted electronically, the institutionally endorsed letter of commitment must be faxed or sent via regular mail as described below.
5. An electronic version of the organization's proposal, including the letter of institutional commitment if feasible, must be emailed to fdp@nas.edu. If you do not have the FULL version of Acrobat, you will be able to complete the form online but you will not be able to save the completed form as an electronic document.
