Requesting ideas from the committee on how the Members page can be better viewed. Some suggestions were a page listing by institution and a page listing by last name. The next issue was who should be put on these pages? Is it open for any one to be listed or should it just show the Faculty and Admin. Reps?

We are looking in to building a members directory database, with institutional profile information.

Was recommended that a page be created listing all of the FDP listservs and how to get added to the listserv. The page would state that these list are for FDP related business and anyone violating this will be removed from the listserv.

Jo Ann suggested a balloon for each link on the main page that states what you can find on that link.

The owners of the pages need to make sure the data is up-to-date and links are still active.
