Federal Directory Demonstration

Unique, Common & Shared

- Determine attributes needed for ID
 - Unique ID (Use to map to agency profile)
 - Name
 - E-mail address
 - Mailing Address
 - Institution
- Single ‘sign-on’ to agency resources
- Example: Register with eRA Commons, authenticate in FastLane with same credentials
- Track ‘Federated Authentication’
- Grants.gov web services form to collect data

Federal Directory Demonstration

Linking to Profiles

- Matrix of common data dictionary
- Designated ‘Roles’ (NIH) or tables (NSF)
 - Match NIH, NSF and USDA CSREES
 - Over 1 Million ‘person’ profiles represented
 - 400 thousand reviewer profiles
- SSN used ‘behind scene’ but not exposed
- Link Federal Directory ID to Profiles

Collaboration with NGP National Grants Partnership

- DUNS/CCR Talking Points
- DUNS Survey
 - Sent to FDP membership December 17
 - Return by January 13, 2006 (Extended to ?)
 - Contact Charlie Martin at D&B for list
 - Examine list; use unique registration for Grants and Contracts
 - Develop clear instruction set for institutions

- Grants.gov S2S
 - Award notices
 - Common Reps & Certs
 - Basic Grant Information
 - Reporting to Sponsor
 - Entry point for payment systems

- Expectations for DUNS/CCR Registration



Grants.gov

- Update on Grants.gov system upgrades
- Form within forms in PureEdge cannot be replicated in S2S
- Identify duplicate data requests in Apply
- Repository for basic Grantee authentication
- Change Management



Strategy

- Establishing a demonstration of ‘Federal Directory’ & Profiles
- Leverage our partnership with NGP
- DUNS/CCR (Survey is out)
- Integrated Acquisition Environment
 - Agency access to institutional profile, ‘Reps & Certs’
 - Remove requirement for profile info in each Grants.gov application
- Grants Management Line of Business
- Federal Directory & Profiles
- Proactive on Grants.gov Issues

Strategy (Cont)

Draft FDP/NGP Partnership

- Establish a predictable and effective organizational structure
- Implement routine development process
- Integrate policy development for GMLoB
- Concept or Issue Development leading toward implementation & impact assessment
- Pilot/Demonstration - Test of basic concepts, methods, policy and procedure
