# Update on Uncosted Carryover of Funds

---

- In NASA's FY10 budget appropriation, Congress expressed concern that awarded funds remained unspent
- On 30 Sept 2009, NASA grantee institutions typically had 14 months of unspent funds
- By 30 Sept 2010, those unspent amounts had shrunk by about 2 months – progress!
