

SCIENCv OVERVIEW

- ▶ SciENcv = Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae
- ▶ SciENcv interagency working group:
DOD, DOE, EPA, NEH, NIH, NSF, Smithsonian, USDA
- ▶ Create/maintain Biosketches for grant applications
- ▶ Compatible with FDP goals to reduce administrative workload

SciENcv Releases

- **Alpha release: Testing in late July-August 2013**
 - Small group (all faculty) responded with feedback
 - Need more formats (word, etc)
 - Can I delegate to another person?
 - No place (yet) to include other scholarly products of research as in NSF biosketches.
- **Beta release: September 2013 FDP meeting**
 - Supported a single, NIH biosketch profile
 - Linked to eRA Commons profile + grants; Users could add ORCID iD
- **Version 2.0: May 2014 FDP meeting**
 - Support for multiple NIH biosketch profiles
 - Delegation added
 - Multiple export formats available: PDF, XML, MS Word

SciENcv Unreleased Version

- Version 2.1: ORCID integration
 - Currently undergoing final QA checks
 - Users can import profile information from ORCID into SciENcv
 - Citations stored in ORCID profiles made available in SciENcv

SciENcv Unreleased Version

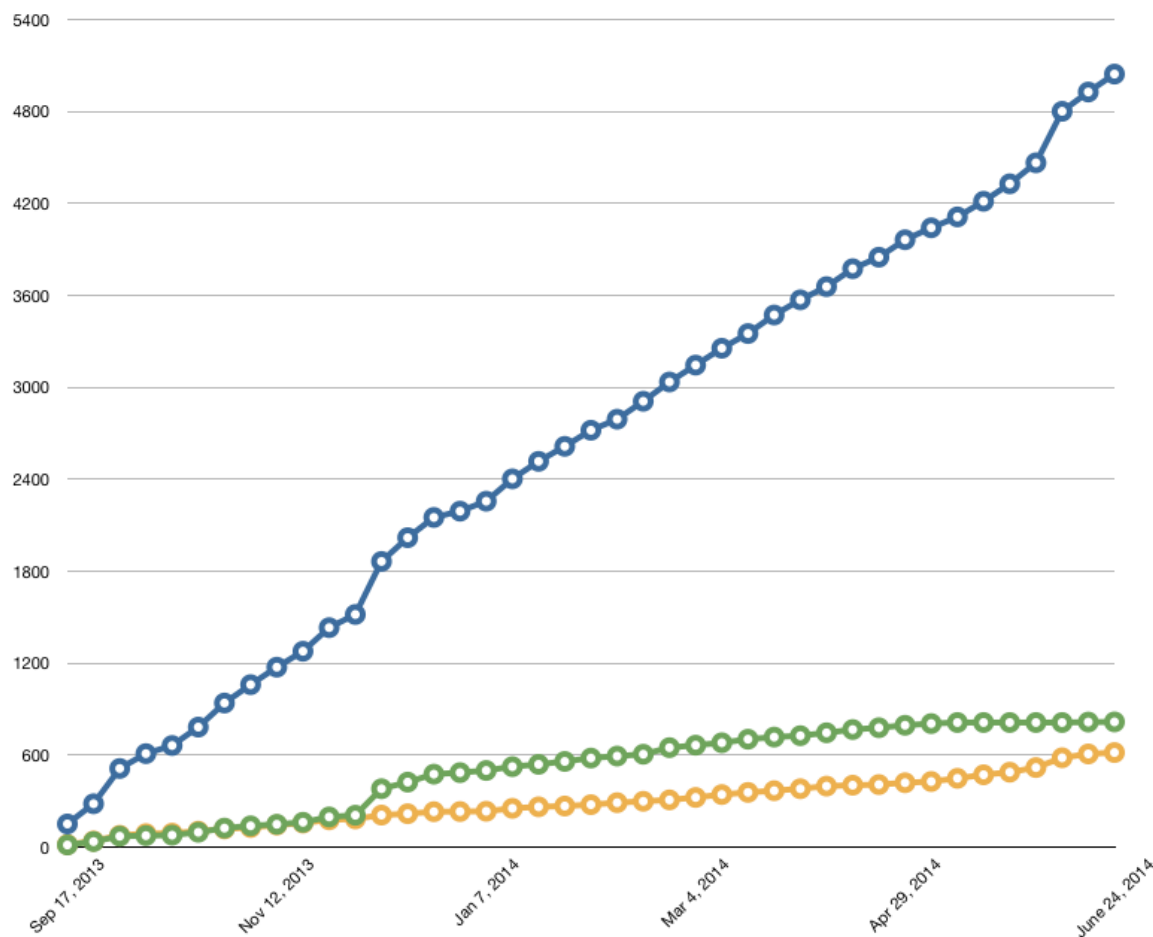
- Version 2.5: NSF integration
 - Development currently underway
 - Users will be able to link their FastLane account to My NCBI
 - NSF biosketch format will be supported
