 - Related: How do radio scientists and meteorologists find one another when the need for synergy is recognized on either side?

USNC Action Items (1 of 3)



1. Starting from 2016 Boulder meeting, the requirement to post a paper in IEEE X-plore is two-page two-column paper. One page USNC-URSI abstracts won't be eligible for IEEE X-plore. The present proposal is to allow people to submit an optional two-page paper (in addition to the one-page abstract) if they want to publish in IEEE X-plore. The two-page paper will require two independent reviews (will need more Commission member volunteers). How does Commission F feel about this proposal?
2. We have two options if we accept the above proposal:
 - a) have all authors submit either their one-page abstract or their two-page summary at the time of initial submission, or
 - b) have all authors submit a one-page abstract at the time of initial submission, and then have the optional two-page summary submitted at a later date for publication on IEEE Xplore (perhaps in time for the conference CD, or perhaps not).

Which option, (a) or (b), does our Commission prefer?

USNC Action Items (2 of 3)



3. In 2020, IEEE APS will be hosted by Montreal. The organizers would like to have a North American Radio Science Meeting. Would Commission F prefer to have a North American Radio Science Meeting or regular IEEE APS/USNC/CNC Radio Science Meeting with only some commissions participating? Should we hold a Boulder meeting in 2020? Note there will also be an URSI GASS in 2020 (will there be too many URSI meetings?)
4. Starting this triennium the International URSI has introduced new officers elected in each commission called Early Career Representative (under 36). They are expected to promote young scientists and students' participation in technical and business activities of URSI. Would Commission F consider introducing such a position?
 - a) Also would Commission F consider a new membership category called student members of USNC-URSI?

5. Does Commission F have any good ideas for plenary talks in the 2016 Boulder meeting on a joint theme with another Commission? Preference will be given to Commissions that have not participated in the recent past.
6. Does Commission F have topics for special sessions in Boulder 2016? Next slide shows known “organized” sessions being considered...
7. Presently, membership qualification guidelines list a minimum number of single-author papers. Is this still a practical or desirable guideline? What do you feel would be better guideline for Members or Associate Members to have?
8. Will Commission F participate in the 2017 AP Symposium in San Diego?
