




IMPACT: FACULTY ENGAGEMENT


- Culture Change: How do we increase faculty buy in to career training?

- Benefits to Faculty: Importance for recruitment and keeping students motivated




DO TRAINEES WHO PARTICIPATE IN MORE CAREER EVENTS TAKE LONGER TO GRADUATE?
