

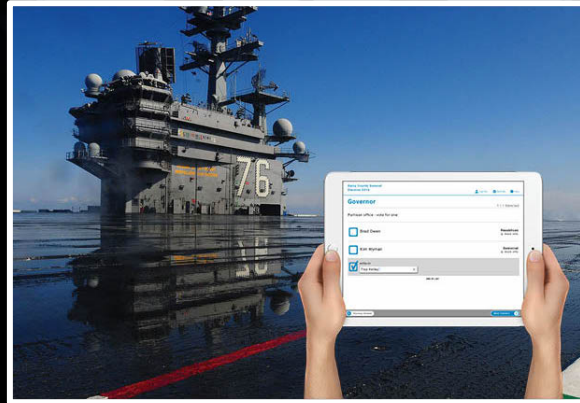

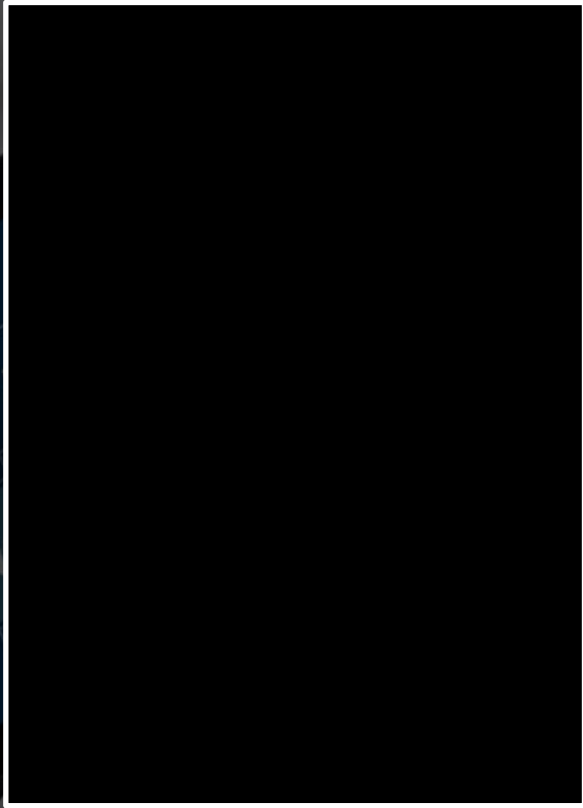
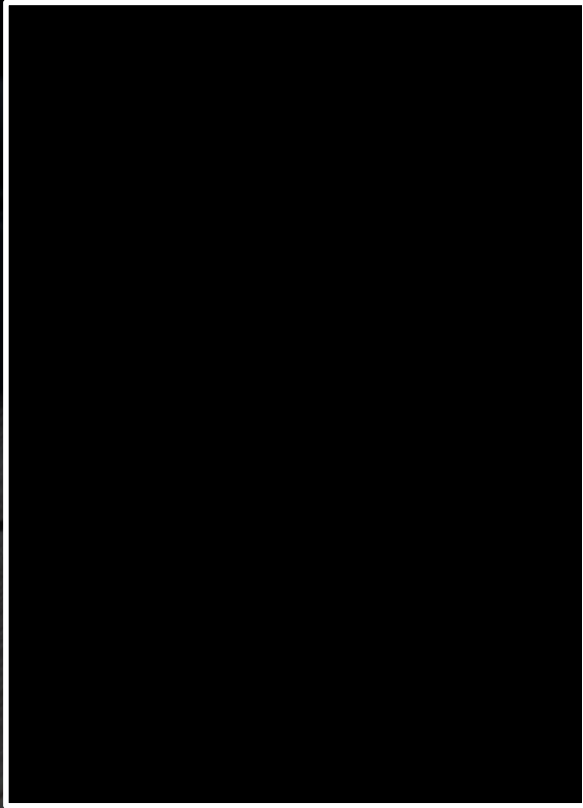

OPPORTUNITIES AND ENABLERS

1)

The current economics of voting technology do not support innovation; vendors can only productize an idea if they have early confidence it is certifiable

2)

The certification process must allow for stakeholders to agree upon specific requirements before implementation begins to keep costly rework to a minimum

3)

Interoperability work under VVSG 2.0 should lead to smaller, component-level certifications; reduced scope results in simpler products and more consistent testing
