 - CCAP: family/provider-friendly provisions

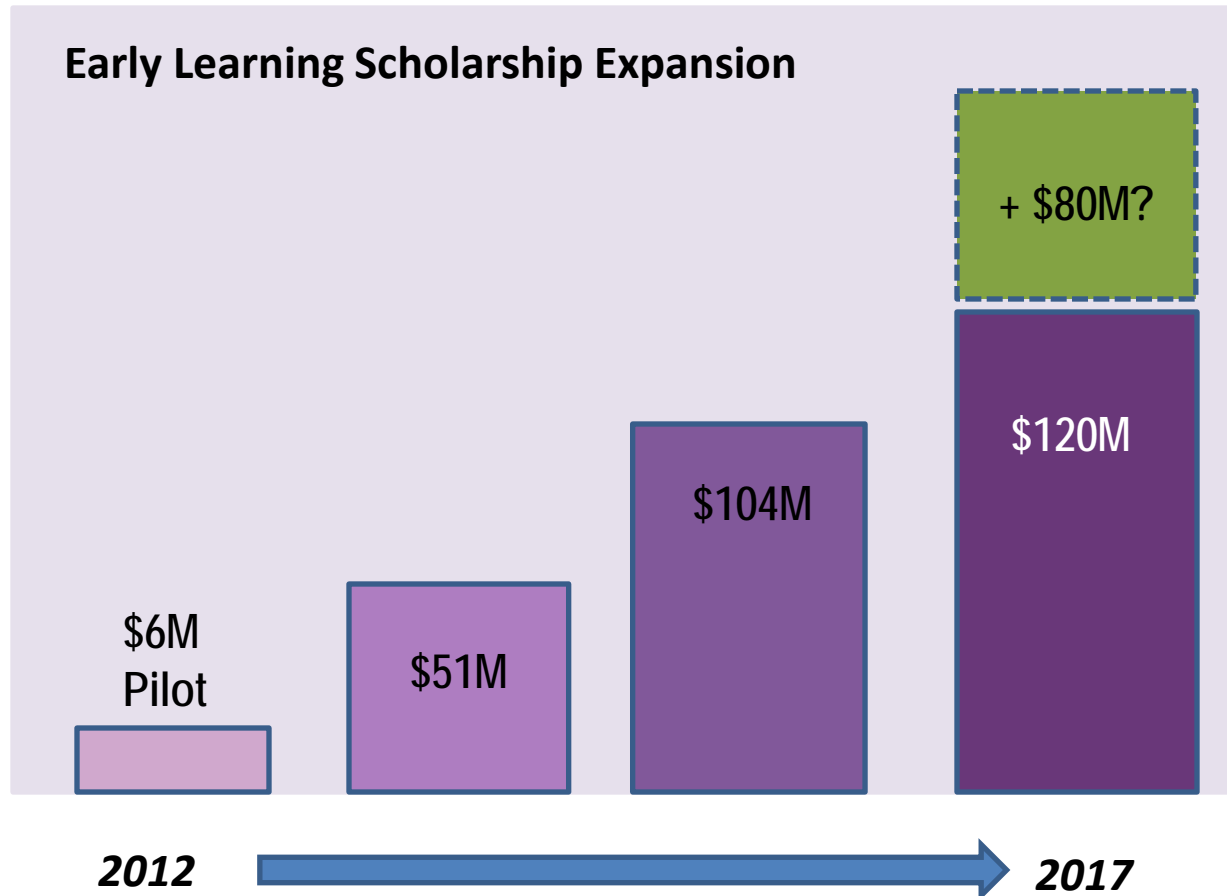

Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten	\$175M	\$0

<u>Total Proposed</u>	\$264M	\$22M
