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# IARPA hosted 4 forecasting tournaments from 2011 to 2015




Will Venezuela experience a domestic political crisis between December 2013 and April 2014?



# The Brier Scoring Rule was the Accuracy Metric



## Brier Scores for a Meteorologist

<u>Day</u>	<u>“Rain”</u>	<u>Rain</u>	<u>Brier Score</u>
1	90%	1	$(1-.9)^2 + (0-.1)^2 = 0.02$
2	40%	0	$(0-.6)^2 + (1-.4)^2 = 0.72$
3	<u>90%</u>	<u>0</u>	<u><math>(0-.9)^2 + (1-.1)^2 = 1.62</math></u>
	73%	33%	0.75



# Steam Engines

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Harnessing steam power required many innovations, among the most important was a new way to measure the energy output of engines.

Measurements were done with a tool called a micrometer (aka the “Lord Chancellor”) that measured tiny distances and allowed innovators to evaluate their ideas.



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<u>Forecasters</u>	Original	Verbal Phrases		
	Brier	Confidence	Unequal	Equal
	<u>Scores</u>	<u>Ratings (3)</u>	<u>Intervals (7)</u>	<u>Intervals (7)</u>
All Forecasters	0.153	11.8%***	0.7%***	1.9%***
Super Forecasters	0.093	236.1%***	6.1%***	40.4%***
