

New institutions?

How to allocate ϵ ?

- Across researchers/ users/ ...
- Across institutions
- Over time

We already do: after 72 years, we set $\epsilon = \infty$ for census records.

New institutions?

- Universities have IRB to **allow/disallow** research for ethical reasons
- XSEDE has a review board to **allocate finite compute resources**
- **Pre-registered reports** peer-review study at design stage before proceeding to collection/analysis
