Summary of Changes to the FDP General Terms and Conditions and Agency Specific Requirements

- 1) The material from the 7/97 General Terms and Conditions is now found in four separate documents
 - a) The FDP General Terms and Conditions, which are side-by-side with OMB Circular A-110, incorporating A-110 by reference, and indicating election of awarding agency options. (See the "Crosswalk" below for a explanation of where current terms and conditions are in the proposed terms and conditions.)
 - b) The Operating Procedures, which
 - i) Describes how the terms and conditions are to be used by agencies, and the order of precedence
 - ii) States the authority sited in making these rules
 - iii) Provides definition of terms
 - iv) Describes what matters are reserved to the Agency Specific Requirements, and provides a standard format for them
 - v) Prescribes how revisions are to be made
 - vi) Provides guidance about terms and conditions to use for sub-recipients (See Appendix A)
 - vii) Provides guidance about national policy requirements (See Appendix B)
 - viii) Supports use of electronic research administration
 - ix) Provides an information contact
 - x) Provides an effective date for the General Terms and Conditions
 - c) <u>Appendix A to the Operating Procedures</u> citations to incorporate proper terms and conditions in subawards
 - d) <u>Appendix B to the Operating Procedures</u> National Policy Requirements (*These appendices will be continuously updated as changes occur in Federal laws, and in agency regulations applying to non-FDP subrecipients, without having to issue new versions of the Terms and Conditions.*)
- 2) The blanket exemption for Federal Circulars is replaced by incorporation of these circulars showing agency implementation of flexibility, most of which arose originally from earlier stages of FDP
