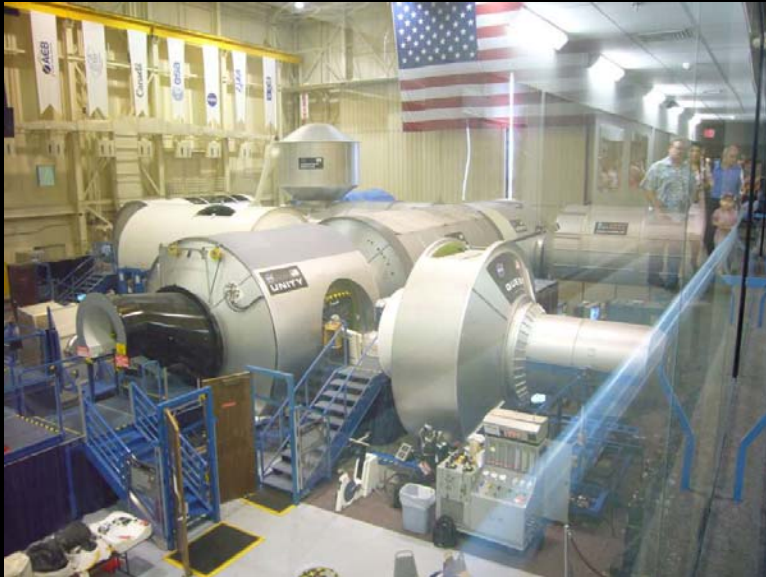

- Single Control List
- Single Primary Coordination Agency
- Single IT System
- Single Licensing Agency


Phase I

(Congress, what Congress?)

- Refine, Harmonize, Understand the Lists
- Streamline Licensing
- Synchronize and De-Conflict by Creating an 'Enforcement Fusion Center'
- Establish a Single IT Point of Entry


Phase II

(Congressional Notification Required)

- Control List Restructuring into Identical Tiered Structures
 - Revise Licensing Accordingly
 - Enforcement- Expand Outreach and Compliance
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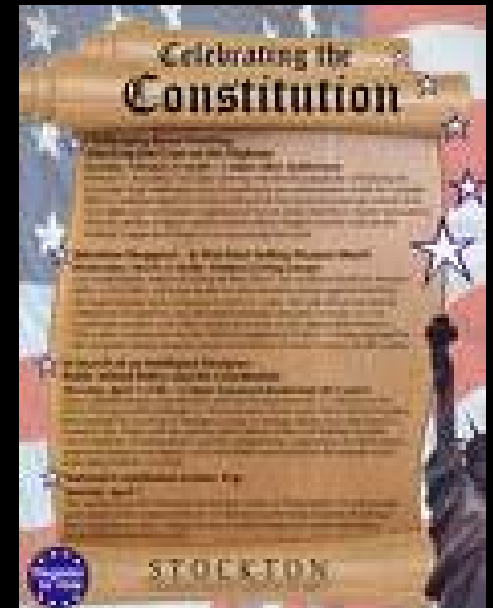
Phase III

(Congressional Legislation Required)

- Control List- Merge the two lists into a single list
 - Licensing- Implement Single Licensing Agency
 - IT- Single IT System
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Unconstitutional ITAR

- Prior Restraint on Free Speech
- Too broad, not sufficiently narrowly tailored for its purpose
- Does not protect a significant governmental interest
- No hard deadlines
- No expeditious judicial review
