Dr. Yasuhiro Murayama is a director of Integrated Science Data System Research Laboratory of National Institute of Information and Communications Technology (NICT), Japan. He is in charge of WDS-IPO business in NICT and plays a role of liaison with ICSU and WDS-science committee. From 1999-2006 he had been a leader of Japan group of US-Japan joint program of Arctic middle-upper atmosphere observations in Alaska, and then he was appointed as a group leader of NICT's whole atmospheric remote sensing group in 2008-2011. He was awarded by Japan's Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology in 2007, for Internet use of high-quality Auroral image observation and live image distribution. Dr. Murayama received his Ph.D. from Kyoto University studying atmospheric dynamics using remote-sensing and sounding rocket techniques.
