Report on USNC URSI Committee Meeting (January 4, 2009)

- The General Assembly in Chicago was successfully held.
 - USNC had to sponsor about \$250,000 to make up for lower registration than expected (1200 vs 1500)
 - USNC held a student paper competition for the first time in GA, and it was very successful.
- Next General Assembly will be held in Istanbul, Turkey, August 13-20, 2011
 - USNC will propose to sponsor the student paper competition there as well.

Report Continued

- This year some changes are introduced in the conference.
 - 3 day meeting instead of 4 days.
 - Lunch boxes will be offered for purchase
 - Luncheon will be offered to student participants and USNC officers after the plenary session on Wednesday.

- Commissions are asked to keep statistical data on performance.
- The next General Assembly will be held in Istanbul, Turkey in 2011.

Action Items from USNC URSI Committee Meeting

- Member opinion requested on holding the NRSM meeting over 3 days instead of 4.
 - Typically 2 parallel sessions per commission is scheduled.
 - This will be based on number of submissions.

Action Items Continued

- USNC requests nominations for government representatives from all commissions. Three positions will be filled by vote.
- List of proposed special sessions for the 2010 NRSM meeting is due January 8, 2009.
 - Need title, organizer name and e-mail.
 - Organizer must have agreed.
 - Financial support for commissions will be based on commission activities.
 - Papers in joint sessions are counted for both commissions.
 - Commission A needs to be more active
 - 18 out of 294 papers were submitted for Commission A. Commission A has 3 sessions this year, one special session "Dielectric and Magnetic Measurements" by James-Baker Jarvis and Michael Janezic.

Action Items Continued

- Nominations for member at large is requested from all commissions.
 - These are voting members
 - Service as member at large is required to be a USNC officer
 - Would like to use this as a possible recruitment for promising young members

Action Items Continued

- Member opinions on the number of authors for student paper competitions is requested.
 - Some papers had more than four authors this year.
 - Should we limit the authors to the student and up to 2 advisors?
 - Currently all advisors submit a letter stating that the student carried out most of the work and their participation was purely advisory.

Action Items Continued

- Member opinion on student travel awards is requested.
 - The number of student papers have been increasing each year. This year 91 students are supported (\$600 each).
 - This rate of increase will not be sustainable in the future.
 - Should we limit a student no more than 2 awards?
 - This is to encourage new participation.

- All commissions are encouraged to have a secretary.
- Nominations for secretary position for Commission A?
