MINUTES Commission B Business meeting

AP-S/URSI International Symposium
San Antonio, TX
June 17, 2002

1. Chair P. L. E. Uslenghi called the meeting to order at 17:00 hrs. He welcomed all members and guests. Attendance list is provided at the end of the minutes.
2. The minutes of the January 9, 2002 meeting of Commission B held at Boulder, CO were approved.

Report from the Chair

3. Professor Uslenghi reported that Professor Y. T. Lo passed away on May 10, 2002. A moment of silence was observed in his honor. Professor W. C. Chew made the announcement that a memorial fund is being set up. Individuals interested in contributing should contact him.
4. Chair announced that a check in support of travel to participate is in mail for those members who are attending the General Assembly in Maastricht.
5. Professor David Jackson was elected Vice-Chair for the Commission for the next triennium.
