

Minutes of the USNC/URSI Commission F Business Meeting
National Radio Science Meeting
University of Colorado, Boulder, Colorado
January 6, 2006

1. Roger Lang called the meeting to order at 1805 MST.
2. The minutes of the USNC URSI Comm F Business Meeting from Jan. 2005 were approved.
3. Nominations:

All were elected as new Members of Comm F.
4. A discussion was held of the Guideline for URSI Membership that mentions the number of single-author articles, as follows. "Minimum publication numbers should be 1-2 single-author articles with 2-3 publications overall for Associate Member, and 3-4 single-author articles with 5-6 publications overall for Full Member." The USNC Commission F Members present voted to waive the single-author article recommendation for those applying for Membership in Commission F. The Guidelines for Membership continue, "Allowances will be made for fewer articles of special significance and in cases where the research area typically involves teams more often than individuals."
5. Present Meeting:
 - a. Need to make an effort to increase the number of sessions by organizing Special Sessions.
 - b. Question: Do we want to add a Student Membership for URSI? We need to track the students' continuing involvement. This is a USNC-wide issue and will continue to be discussed at USNC/URSI meetings.
6. Future Meetings:
 - a. Ross Stone invited Comm F to participate in the 2008 AP-S/URSI Meeting, San Diego, July 5-11, 2008. We want to give a strong showing at that meeting. San Diego is a great place to visit!
 - b. 2008 URSI General Assembly, Chicago, IL, August 7-16, 2008
 - c. We need to talk with Yahia Antar about the change in dates of the North American Radio Science Meeting and the conflict with IGARSS in Barcelona, Spain. Roger and Al will do this.
7. Action Items:
 - a. We voted to participate in the AP-S/URSI 2008 meeting in San Diego. We want to focus on propagation sessions due to the overlap in dates between the AP-S/URSI meeting in San Diego and IGARSS'08 in Boston.
 - b. AP-S/URSI Meetings: General Issues
 - i. IEEE AP-S wants to limit the number of parallel sessions to 12-15 and would like all USNC/URSI Commissions to comment on this. We voted to tell them that we agree.

- ii. Poster sessions are to be an integral part of meetings. The Special Sessions Committee will choose the topics that should be Poster Sessions after abstract submission. We voted to tell AP-S that we agree.

8. New Business:

- a. We need to recognize Kenn Anderson for his service to USNC as Commission F Chair and his service as webmaster for USNC. Roger Lang will write a letter to Kenn. The Members attending the meeting gave him their unanimous consent.
- b. We want to ask USNC whether or not undergraduates can participate in the Student Paper Competition.
