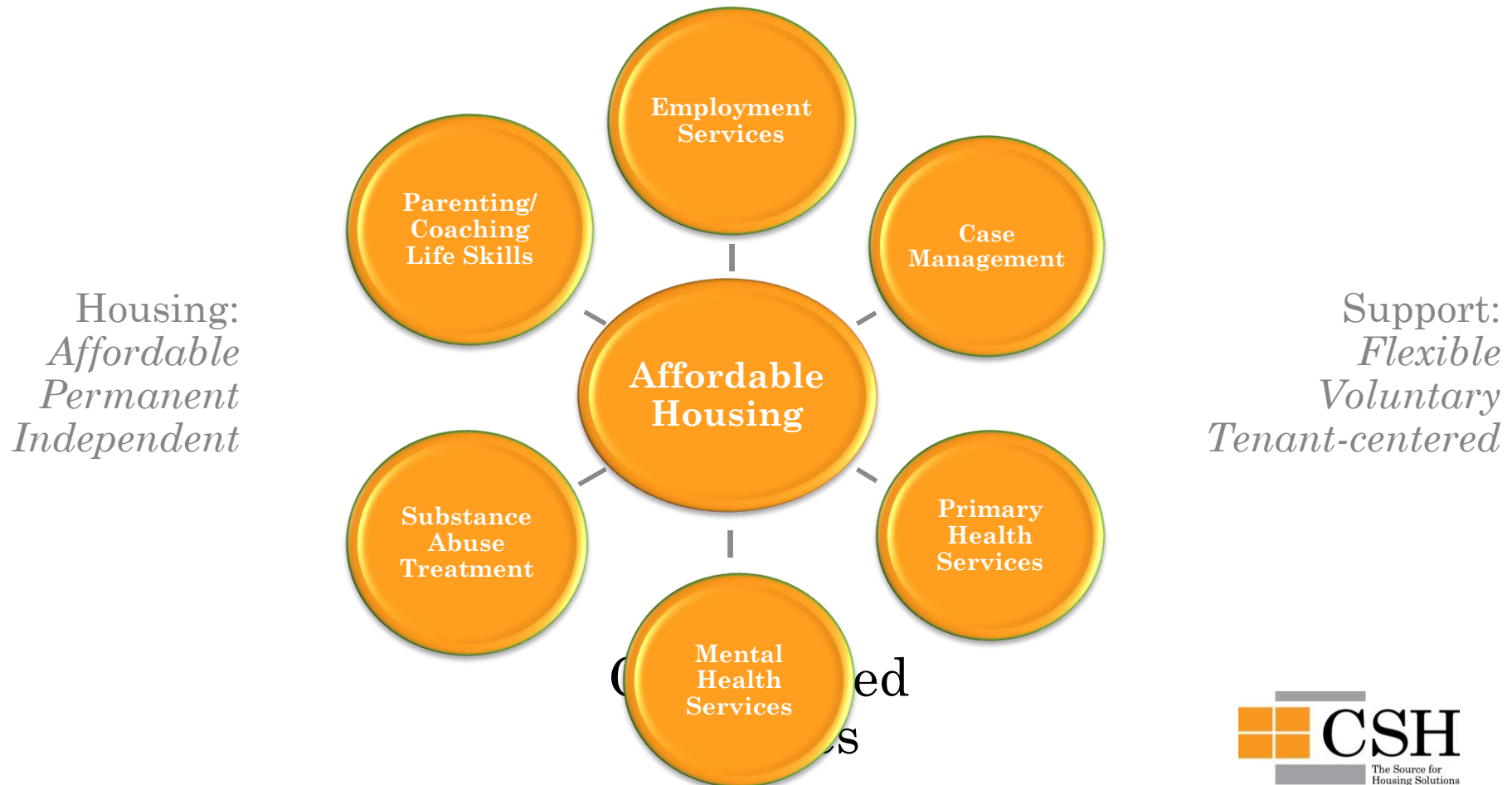
# Supportive Housing is for People Who:

- ❑ Due to a disability need additional assistance beyond a rental subsidy.
- ❑ Are chronically homeless.
- ❑ Cycle through institutional and emergency systems and are at risk of long-term homelessness.
- ❑ Are being discharged from institutions and systems of care.
- ❑ Without housing, cannot access and make effective use of treatment and supportive services.



# Supportive Housing is the Solution

**Supportive housing combines affordable housing with services that help people who face the most complex challenges to live with stability, autonomy and dignity.**



# The state of the literature on Supportive Housing

## 33 Studies Published

- 10 in Peer Reviewed Journals
- 23 as Reports or Policy Briefs

## Study Design

- 24 studies were a Pre/Post Test Design
- 9 were Randomized Control Trials

## Populations

- Adults with Behavioral Health- 12 studies
- People Experiencing Homelessness- 15 studies
- High Utilizers of Health Care- 6 studies

# Outcome Measures from Current Studies

## Housing Status

- Rates of Homelessness
- Housing Stability
- Shelter Days

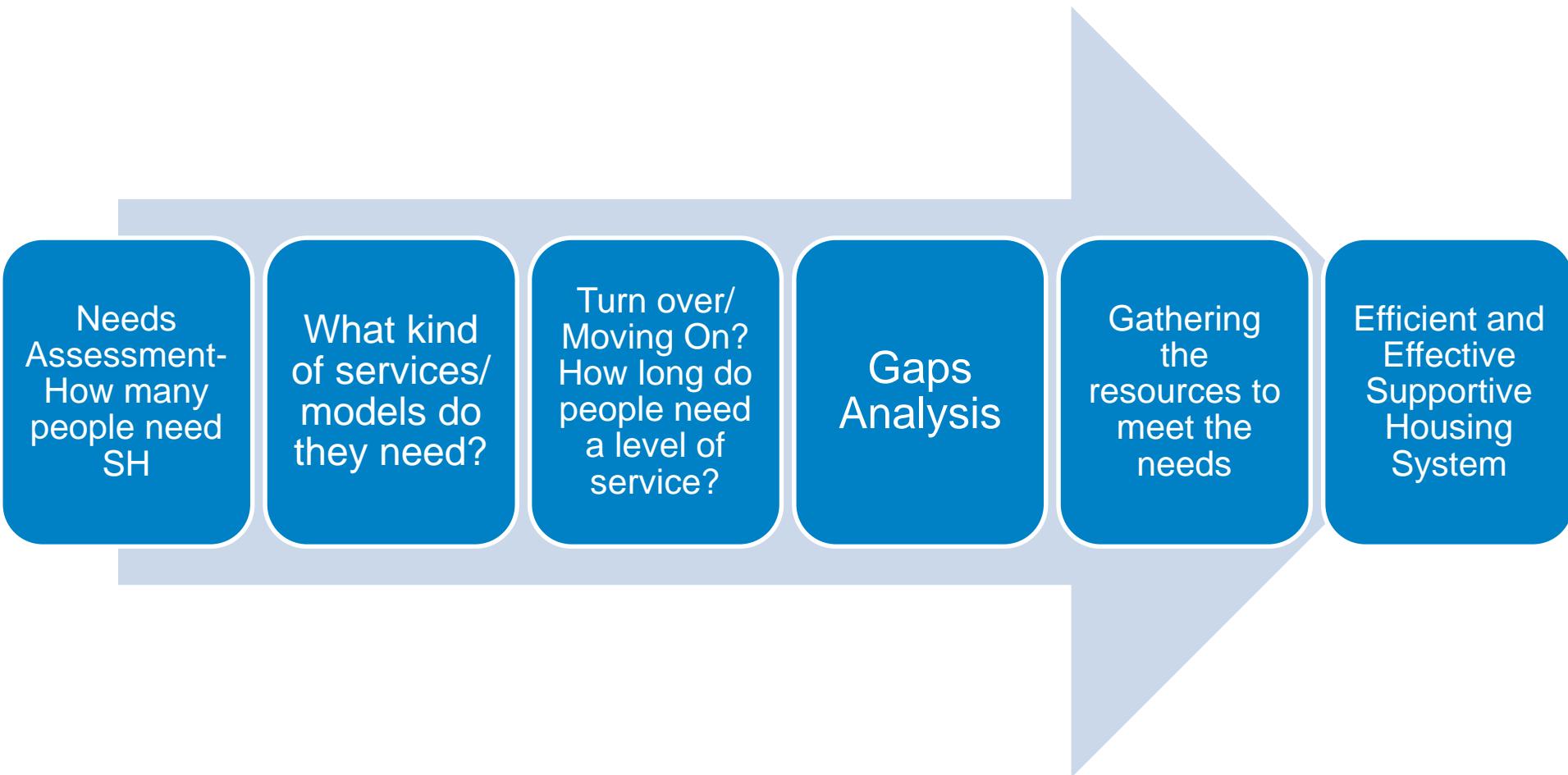
## Health Care Costs

- Ambulance Trips
- ED visits
- Hospitalizations
- Hospital Bed Days
- Detox Visits
- Outpatient Visits

## Health Outcomes

- Rates of or impact on Substance Use- 6 studies
- Rates of or impact on Psychiatric Symptoms- 1 study
- Rates of HIV infection- 1 study
